

HANCOCK COUNTY BAR HARBOR AIRPORT AIRCRAFT LANDING FEE PROGRAM

As of January 1, 2025, the Hancock County Bar Harbor Airport [BHB] will enact an Aircraft Landing Fee Program for all 14CFR135 charter operations and/or aircraft greater or equal to 6000lbs Max Takeoff Weight (MTOW) at a rate of \$3.25 per 1000lbs MTOW. To offset costs associated with properly maintaining the aircraft movement areas and facilities. This is a way to supplement it revenues for airport maintenance and operation. Similarly, to the airport's Aircraft Parking Program, Landing Fees are charged to aid in revenues to maintain and operate the Airport. The program is intended to impose fair and reasonable charges in association with transient usage of BHB. It allows exemptions for aircraft owned by the US Government, official aircraft of the State of Maine, aircraft engaged in non-profit patient airlift services, BHB based aircraft, and Maine based aircraft providing flight instruction.

LANDING FEE STRUCTURE

LANDING FEES:

All 14CFR135 Operations	\$3.25/1000lbs
All Aircraft At or Above 6000lbs MTOW	\$3.25/1000lbs

Exempt Aircraft

Aircraft owned by the US Government, official aircraft of the State of Maine, aircraft engaged in non-profit patient airlift services, BHB based aircraft, Maine based aircraft providing flight instruction.

Based Aircraft is defined as an aircraft that has an agreement with BHB or its FBO's for parking or hangar space

OPERATIONAL CONTROL/MONITORING:

The Airport will collaborate with a third-party vendor to manage and collect these Fees.


PROGRAM REVIEW:

The rates will be reviewed in the fourth quarter of each year, and any adjustments shall be made prior to the start of the next year after Commissioner approval. The review will consist of; reviewing the fees of the airports in the region, to determine if the Landing Fee rate at BHB are consistent with the region.
